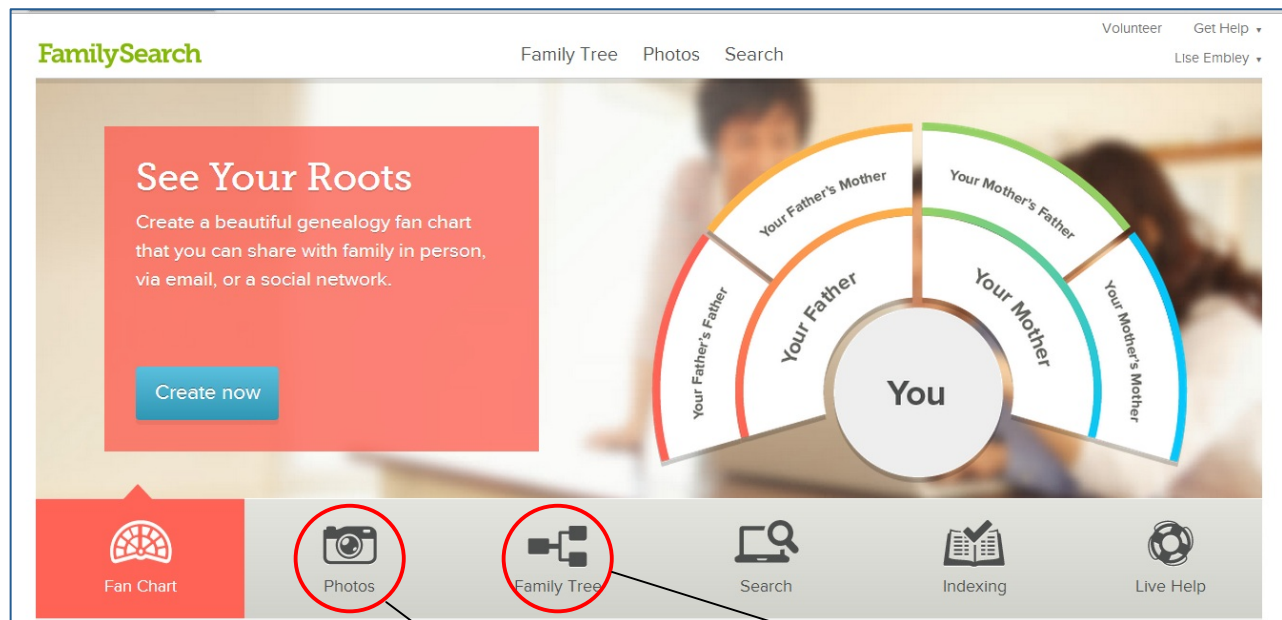

- Quick way to see where you have info, gaps in the Family Tree.
- Hyper-linked for simple navigation.
- Color coded by line.

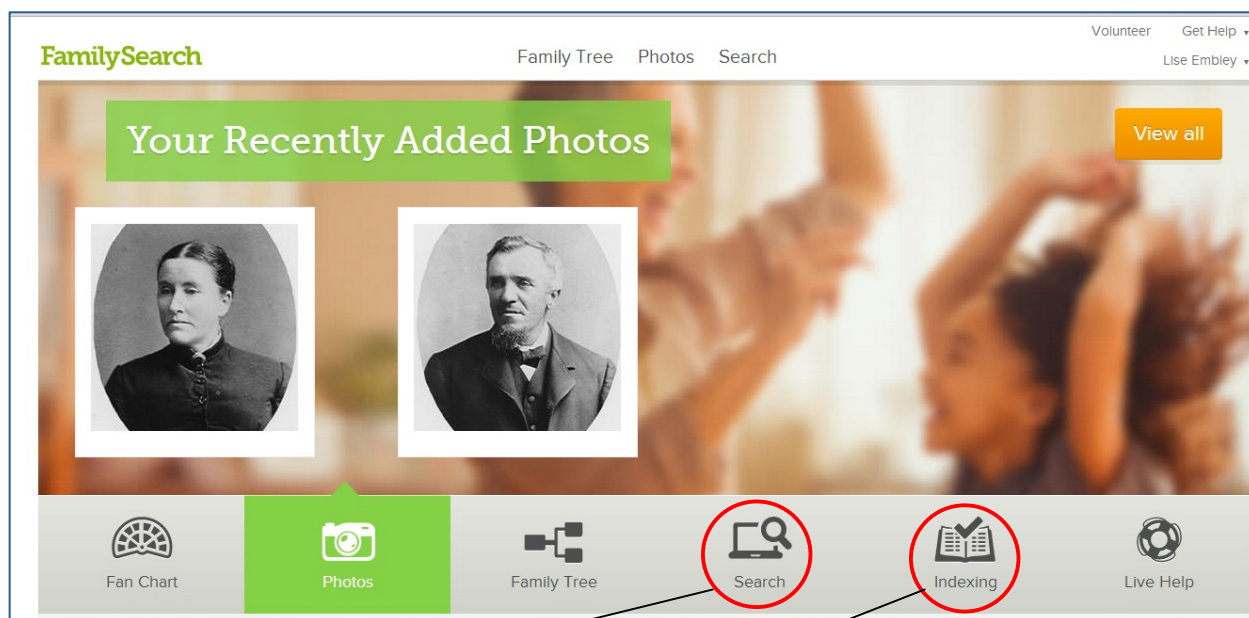
Photos

- **Add**
 - Upload photos
 - Create albums
 - Share stories
 - Find photos of your ancestors
- **Tag**
Identify people in photos
- **Connect**
Connect photos to people in the Family Tree – even to people who are not related to you.
- **Share**
Via social media

Family Tree

View pedigree, fan chart or individual person record.

- See everything connected to an individual.
- Add details, attach sources, correct info.
- Use “Watch” to receive notification of changes via weekly email.
- Check “History” to see what others have added/changed.
