

- Hyper-linked for simple navigation.
- Color coded by line.

Connect photos to people in the Family Tree – even to people who are not related to you.



Family Tree

View pedigree, fan chart or individual person record.

- See everything connected to an individual.
- Add details, attach sources, correct info.
- Use "Watch" to receive notification of changes via weekly email.
- Check "History" to see what others have added/changed.

- Genealogies
 AF, PRF, + individually submitted GEDCOMs
- FHL Catalog
 Locate and order film here
- Books
 Digitized books from seven major libraries
- Wiki "Wikipedia" of genealogy
