1. Birth record — Baby blanket:
Precious child

2. School Graduation record — Lunch box:

3. 1920 Census — Map:

11. Baptism record — Baptism photo:
 A day you'll always remember
 You've been cleansed from all your sins
 To walk in newness as your life a new begins

12. Death record — Wrist watch/stethoscope:
 When time has gone away

 The reason to be told
 Has been revealed from a doctor's report

Instructions:

1. Each child receives a clue (placed in a box)
2. Each selects an article from the clue (articles on the tables)
3. Each finds a record matching the clue & article (records taped to each computer monitor)
4. Write the names from the record onto a slip of paper (strips of colored paper by each computer)
5. Each child reports what record they found (returns to seat and shares)
6. Staple the slips of paper to form a chain (chain represents a family found and connected)

List instructions on the chalk board 1. Clues, 2. Articles, 3. Records, 4. Slips of Paper 5. Return and Share
 6. Build Chain

List types of records to be found on the inside door of the computer room.
