Advanced Find A Grave

Class presented by Fred Turner on September 28, 2022

This class will look in detail at a number of different types of information found on Find A Grave Memorials. Be open minded because many of these hints will lead you to other documents, review of sources on multiple databases, including Ancestry, Find My Past, etc.

Your level of research on each individual or family will depend upon how deep you want to dig into their piece of your families' history. Verifying the accuracy of basic information about each individual begins with attaching sources showing where each data point was found. That is the first step, the genealogy function of Family History.

In the beginning, we were asked to document at least four generations of the Patriarchal line. Many of the records in Family Tree contain only those individuals. Their parents or siblings were not entered. In many cases source attachments were not connected to individuals included in Census, Obituary, or other records.

The Church has recently asked that we expand our search to include additional information about other ancestors and their lines. Each individual must determine how obsessed or addicted they are to "digging into history." There are no Recovery groups for Genealogist, because no one wants to be cured.

Dig as deep as you choose, but there is more treasure to be found in the next document you dig up. Remember that over 1 million records from across the world are added to Family Search each day. Review your tree at least once a month to find new hints.

Understanding the symbols found on and around the grave can add to the understanding of your ancestors. What religion, Masons, Grand Dame, DAR/SAR, military service, Woodman, can all be revealed in these symbols and clues. I have included a list of sites for your enjoyment.

Find A Grave Examples

<u>Dr Fred Turner Jr. (1920-2016) - Find a Grave Memorial</u> 174105253 Unique stone, Veteran, Spouse name and birth date. This person had 3 spouses, but FAG only shows 2.

<u>Hinton Carr (1859-1921) - Find a Grave Memorial</u> 13177983 Photo, detail headstone, Death Cert., Obituary with important details. Name of cousin I didn't know about.

Frances Susan "Fannie" Carr Bright (1854-1876) - Find a Grave Memorial 153451864

Nickname, name of child not shown on FAG. Probably died in childbirth. No other children shown on FAG.

Galen McDuff Carr (1922-2002) - Find a Grave Memorial 13177789 More photos, news clipping with family photo, names and ages. Birth Cert. Calculate burial date.

<u>James Dickson Carr (1886-1968) - Find a Grave Memorial</u> 61958255 Detailed Obituary with family history and stories. Beautiful headstone.

<u>Charles Robert "Charlie" Carr (1887-1957) - Find a Grave Memorial</u> 13179058

Military photo & headstone. Residence, marital, and health info.

Rex Allan Werts (1951-2012) - Find a Grave Memorial 113301175 Obituary indicates 2 spouses, children and parents.

<u>Charles Frank Norford (1852-1921) - Find a Grave Memorial</u> 128897853 Additional family names on headstone.

Nicholas H. Kuehn Sr. (1886-1967) - Find a Grave Memorial 179592560 Obituary with country of origin and family members. Another source had wife's maiden name. Found Ellis Island arrival list with additional names.

Nora Daly (unknown-1991) - Find a Grave Memorial 205220325 Unique Headstone with additional information.

Eli Ayer Vickery (1859-1914) - Find a Grave Memorial 42438096 Shows cover of the history of the family book. NO DETAILS
