This class will review sources for researching members of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints (LDS). Many sources are available online and in the Family History Library and can be used to find biographical and historical information about an ancestor. Ward, branch, conference and mission records can be used to find baptismal dates, parents, or other information about an ancestor.

Background Information

- The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints (LDS) was organized in Fayette, New York in 1830
- Settlements in Kirtland, Ohio and Jackson County, Missouri began in 1831
- Early 1830's missionaries sent to Canada
- In 1837 missionaries were sent to the British Isles
- Between 1839 and 1845, Church members began to settle in Nauvoo, Illinois
- Migration to the Great Salt Lake Valley began in 1847
- Perpetual Immigration Fund began in 1849
- Missionaries sent to France, Italy, Switzerland, and Scandinavia beginning in 1850

Time Periods in LDS History

- Early Church, 1830-1847
 - o New York, Ohio, Missouri, Illinois, to Utah
- Pioneer Period, 1847-1869
 - o Crossing the Ocean
 - o Crossing the Plains
- Colonization Period 1869-1900s

 for the city where the ward or branch was located. You can also use, Register of
 Genealogical Society Call Numbers, FHL microfiche 6031507 to find wards, branches,
 conferences, and missions.
 - o FHL has ward records, 1830s to 1948 and Form E's, 1907-1948
 - o Also available at the Church History Library
