1. Use the *GenTeam* gazetteer to answer the following questions for the town of Neudorf:

How many pages of entries are there for the town?	29
You know that Neudorf is in the modern Austrian state of Kärnten. How many entries are there for the town?	Three. There are four results, but the last result, Neudorf, is now known as Nova Vas, and is currently located in Slovenia.
What archive holds the records for all Neudorfs in Kärnten? Is this archive online?	Diözese Gurk. The archive is online.

2. Use the *GenTeam* gazetteer to answer the following questions for the town of Wilhelmsdorf in the Czech Republic:

How many Wilhelmsdorf entries are there in Czechia?	Three. There are eight total hits, but only three are in the Crown Land of Böhmen.
List the modern names for the Wilhelmsdorf entries:	Chaloupky Vilémovské and Vilémovské Chaloupky
List all parishes that could contain records for Wilhelmsdorf in Czechia.	Štoky from 1601, and Smrčná from 1784.
What archive holds the records? Is this archive online?	Brünn (Brno) or Zámorsk. Both archives are online.
Bonus: What is the modern district (okres) and province (kraj) for Wilhelmsdorf? Hint: Use the names of the parishes.	District/Okres: Jihlava; province/kraj: Vysočina. If the town Vilémovské Chaloupky is difficult to find, look for the parish of Smrčná.

3. Use the *GenTeam* gazetteer to answer the following questions for the town of Romanova:

What is the Hungarian name of the town?	Románfalu. The current place name is Rumanová and is currently located in Slovakia.
What is the church parish, and when do the earliest marriage records begin?	Maly Bab (today Bab). The marriage records begin in 1721 (baptisms in 1734). The duplicate parish records begin in 1827.
What other religious records are available for this place?	Jewish.
