

FamilySearch Indexing

**Australia, Queensland—
Cemetery Records,
1811–1985 [Part B]**

Some things to remember as you index this project:

- Index a name only if the document contains either a surname, the name of a spouse, or an event date for the person.
- When a married couple is listed, index the first-listed person as the principal person in the record, unless only the spouse was listed with a death date. Then the person for whom a death date was recorded would be indexed as the principal person.
- Create a second record for the spouse only if a death date was listed for both the husband and the wife.
- An ampersand or parenthesis will often denote a spouse, but not always.

As you view this presentation sometimes a second slide will be included following the document to show how the document would be indexed.



You may encounter many types of documents. If they contain a name, index them. This document contains a principal, a spouse, and a marriage date. The first person listed would be indexed as the principal. On this record the principal, Annie M, would have no surname recorded. Only one record would be created since there is no death date for the spouse. (See next slide.)

Create a record for each name on the card. The death date, 1879, would be indexed only with the record for Lizzie Raymont. In this project, if there is a person with only a given name and no surname, event date, or spouse recorded, no record is created, as in the name of Annie in the purple box. Index the names in the order shown.

“MISTAKE” FIRE KILLED A DIGGER

NUI DAT (AAP). *Aug 16 1969* An ~~Australian~~
National Serviceman was killed and another
seriously wounded when they were acci-
dently hit by bullets from an Australian
Task Force sentry group.

A full investigation has been launched into the August 11 tragedy, which occurred in Phuoc Tuy province when the sentry group, operating in thick jungle, heard movement outside their perimeter and opened fires.

An army spokesman in Canberra named the dead man as Private Baron Frederick Smith, 21, single, of Toorak (Vic.).

Seriously wounded was Private Bruce John Ritchie, 22, single of Old Bar, via Taree, (N.S.W.), who is in the 1st Australian Field Hospital at Vung Tau.

The men were from 6 Platoon, Bravo Company, of the 5th Battalion.

Private Smith's death

was announced at a battle casualty by the Army last Tuesday, when initial advice indicated the shooting occurred during an engagement with the enemy.

Meanwhile it was announced yesterday that Australian troops suffered light casualties in a fight with six Viet Cong guerrillas about 12 miles northwest of Nui Dat on Thursday.


Men from the 5th Battalion's 5 Platoon of Bravo Company saw the guerrilla group and opened fire, killing two and wounding one.

The Viet Cong — all in traditional black pyjamas — hit back with rocket-propelled grenades and automatic rifle fire.
