


Poznan Project – Index to Marriages, 1800-1899

About Posen and the Poznan Project

- Posen records timeline:
 - 1815-1848 Part of Grand Duchy of Posen
 - 1848-1871 Province of Prussia
 - 1871-1918 Part of German Empire
 - 1919 Ceded to Second Polish Republic in Treaty of Versailles
- Index is crowd-sourced, covers both civil and church records (both Catholic and Protestant) for the area.
- Original project covered 1835-1884, now expanded to include 1800-1899.
- Approximately 75% of *available* records have been indexed. Project is ongoing. (You can help!)

	<p>Start with a Simple search. http://poznan-project.psnk.pl/?lang=en Results show geographic clusters. Not particularly helpful for more common surnames.</p>
<p>Search mode: Data for both spouses</p> <p>Specify at least one last name or both first names</p> <p>First name: Any Last name: <input type="text"/></p> <p>First name: Any Last name: <input type="text"/></p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Browse also maiden names of brides' and grooms' mothers.</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Use complex algorithm. Caution - searching time may be much longer.</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Match spouses without lastnames.</p>	<p>Refine your search. Choose a first name/variant from the list or [Any]. Note the icons for male and female search criteria. Before 1820, families in Poland did not have fixed surnames ("spouses without lastnames").</p>



Add additional criteria.

[Pull down] / [Pull up] to control access to fields.

Use location, religion, years to narrow results.

Protestant = Lutheran

Sub-regions defined by district groupings in 1890.

Select a location and define search radius.

Displays both German and Polish names for same location.

Narrow or expand search radius to get fewer or more results.

Review results.

Location names parish, gives record availability.

Original record specifies archive/FHL film. Order the film to see the full record.

Add to clipboard to save multiple search results.

Use multiple databases in combination.

Leverage FamilySearch, Ancestry, MyHeritage, Wielkopolska Genealogical Society (WTG "Gniazdo"), State Archives in Poznan, and others.

Review District contents.

Date range, number of records, when published.

Green check = complete.
