

Ireland - Tithe Applotment Books 1824-1840

- Index all names of individuals found on your image. Names may be located in columns for Townlands, in columns for occupiers and proprietors, in the heading of the document, or even written along the side of the document. Please check the image thoroughly to find all names.
- Some images may have include names for both a ploughland or a townland and a subdenomination. Please index both of them in the Townland field.
- In you download an image that is a letter, please index it if it includes any names of individuals. You may need to mark some fields blank.






The titles Archdeacon and Mr. are not indexed - this project does not have a field for titles/terms.

Do not expand contracted or abbreviated given names. Index what is written. The last one or two letters of a contracted name are often smaller and higher up. Examples: Michl, Anthoy, Edwd and Mathw are formed by omitting some letters.

Widw is a contraction of the title Widow. Do not index this title as a given name.

Names may wrap from one line to another. In this example, there are 6 names on 4 lines.





Leany & John Carry

"And" or "&" may separate given names with a common surname. Index each name on a separate line. A surname may wrap from one line to another.

In this example, there are 9 names on 5 lines




Sometimes the letter "t" is not crossed – there are 4 uncrossed t's in this example.

Often, i's are not dotted.

The raised letters in this example have a decorative squiggle below them.

Do not index titles in the given name field. Blank the field if there is no given name listed. Examples: Mr, Widow, Mrs, Miss, Revd, and Messrs





Do not index titles and terms after names. Examples: Esq, Jun, Senr, Coms, & Co

FGerald is a contraction for the surname FitzGerald. Index what you see written. Do not expand contracted surnames.



The McKeen Padners

Even when "Do" or ditto marks are recorded, index each name only once.

Do not mark any dittoed lines blank.

On the last line, "& Do" refers to "& Partners" on the line above. Index only the names.

It is only necessary to index each complete name one time for each image. In this example, there are 9 names, but 4 names are duplicates.

Abbreviated names are not expanded. Widow is not indexed and the given name is marked Blank.

Disregard terms which pertain to unnamed individuals. Examples: "& ptrs," "and partners," "& Brother," "& Son"

Do not assume the surname on line 4 to be Hennesy when the end of the name is not legible. Index it Henne*

Do not index terms describing land and property features. Examples: Demesne, Bawn, Black, mountain

Mr. Austen, Demesne Tennis Hurley, Bawn Humphry Hennesy, Black
