## **About the California Digital Newspaper Collection**

The California Digital Newspaper Collection contains over 500,000 pages of significant historical California newspapers published from 1846-1922, including the first California newspaper, the Californian, and the first daily California newspaper, the Daily Alta California.

- Search by a person's name, or browse by newspaper title or date.
- Searchable Text was created using Optical Character Recognition (OCR). This means that there are easily recognizable errors in the character recognition. You can quickly and easily "Correct this text" and help others find things more easily ("pay it forward").
- Newspapers published before January 1, 1923 are in the public domain and have no restrictions on use. To cite the collection if you do publish, quote from or reproduce an article: California Digital Newspaper Collection, Center for Bibliographic Studies and Research, University of California, Riverside, <a href="http://cdnc.ucr.edu">http://cdnc.ucr.edu</a>>.
- The history of several of the major newspapers can be found under "Other Documents".
- The website also includes issues of several current (2000-2012) California newspapers that are
  part of a pilot project to preserve and provide access to contemporary papers.
